ZOO SAFETY

Adults are responsible for the safety of their children. Children must be supervised at all times. For your safety and the welfare of the animals, please obey all posted signs and guidelines.

- A parent or guardian must accompany children 12 years of age or under.
- Never chase, yell, harass, or tease the animals.
- Never run or climb on rocks.
- Pets of any kind are prohibited at the zoo for reasons of animal health and safety.
- Please treat the animals with the respect they deserve. Remember, you are visiting the animals' in their home.
- Do Not Throw Objects anywhere except in the trash containers. Foreign objects like coins, rocks, straws or any plastic can and have injured and even killed animals in Zoos.
- Animal Diets include specific foods. Any food not part of that diet may be harmful. It is ILLEGAL according to the USDA to bring food for the animals into the Zoo. Feeding of animals is allowed in the animal encounter area, deer, aoudad, and camel with food that is provided by our facility. Critter Food Treats available for purchase in Gift Shop. Also feed machines are located throughout the park.
- Stay on the Walkways. Never cross any fence or barrier.
-  **Disabilities Note:** We are partially wheelchair accessible. The zoo is on natural terrain, which means there are slight inclines, gravel, sand, and grass to manage.  **No wheelchair rentals.**
- Wash Your Hands after touching animals, especially before eating.
- Keep your shirt on! And your shoes too!
